HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ARKANSAS SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION  
COMMISSION TO CONSIDER RECREATIONAL, TOURISM AND RESIDENTIAL  
DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES IN ITS EAST ARKANSAS REGION  
COMPREHENSIVE STUDY.

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation Commission is  
conducting an East Arkansas Region Comprehensive Study of water supplies,  
flood control and drainage; and

WHEREAS, in conducting the study it will advantageous for the  
Commission to consider recreational opportunities, tourism development and  
residential development because tourism is largely an untapped opportunity for  
the East Arkansas Region, and since the Region is within easy commuting  
distance to Memphis, it is ripe for recreational and residential development,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL  
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That the Soil and Water Conservation Commission is hereby requested to  
consider recreational opportunities, tourism development and residential  
development in the East Arkansas Region while conducting its East Arkansas  
Region Comprehensive Study of water supply, flood control and drainage.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Arkansas Industrial Development  
Commission and the Department of Parks and Tourism are requested to assist  
the Soil and Water Conservation Commission in the study.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Soil and Water Conservation Commission  
is requested to file its report with the Joint Interim Committee on  
Agriculture and Economic Development and each member of the House who  
represents an area within the 24 counties included in the study.
