HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC
TRANSPORTATION TO MAKE A STUDY OF THE FEASIBILITY OF
REQUIRING THAT A LICENSE PLATE BE ATTACHED BOTH TO THE FRONT
AND REAR OF ALL AUTOMOBILES AND CLASS ONE TRUCKS.

WHEREAS, some law enforcement agencies believe that the display of a license plate on both the front and the rear of automobiles and Class One trucks would be helpful in combating the illicit trafficking in drugs,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That the Joint Interim Committee on Public Transportation is requested to make a study of the feasibility of enacting legislation to require that a license plate be displayed on both the front and rear of all automobiles and Class One trucks registered in the state. The study shall include a determination of the additional cost of requiring that license plates be displayed on both the front and rear of such vehicles, possible alternative methods of funding such additional costs, and such other matters as the committee deems appropriate to determine the feasibility of enacting such legislation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall report its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly.
