HOUSE RESOLUTION

TO AMEND RULE 11 OF THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF THE 77TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS
REGARDING THE DUTIES OF THE SPEAKER TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION
(q) TO PROVIDE THAT THE SPEAKER SHALL APPOINT AN AD HOC
COMMITTEE OF MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE TO REPORT AND MAKE
RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE HOUSE ON THE SPENDING PRIORITIES FOR
THE STATE AND TO DRAFT THE BILL TO AMEND THE REVENUE
STABILIZATION LAW FOR THE UPCOMING BIENNIUM.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That Rule 11 of the Rules of the House of Representatives of the 77th
General Assembly of the State of Arkansas is hereby amended to add a new
subsection (q) to the duties of the Speaker of the House to read as follows:

"(q) Appoint an ad hoc committee of members of the House of
Representatives to report and make recommendations to the House on the
spending priorities for the State of Arkansas in the next two (2) years and to
draft the bill to amend the Revenue Stabilization Law which will allocate the
available revenues for expenditure during the upcoming fiscal biennium."
