HOUSE RESOLUTION

COMMENDING THE ARKANSAS RAZORBACK BASKETBALL TEAM, COACH
NOLAN RICHARDSON, AND HIS STAFF FOR THEIR SOUTHWEST
CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP IN THE 1988-89 SEASON AND THEIR
DETERMINATION, PRODUCTIVE SPIRIT, AND STEADFASTNESS IN THE
FACE OF ADVERSITY

WHEREAS, the University of Arkansas-Fayetteville Razorback basketball team has won the 1988-89 Southwest Conference championship with an impressive overall record of twenty-one (21) wins and only six (6) losses and with a conference record of thirteen (13) wins and only three (3) losses; and

WHEREAS, the Razorbacks Southwest Conference basketball championship makes them the first team in twenty-two (22) years from the same university that has won both the basketball and football titles in the Southwest Conference; and

WHEREAS, team member Lee Mayberry was named Southwest Conference Newcomer of the Year and team member, and only Senior on this outstanding young team, Keith Wilson was named Southwest Conference Defensive Player of the Year; and

WHEREAS, Coach Nolan Richardson who has compiled an excellent career coaching record in college basketball was named as Southwest Conference Coach of the Year,
