HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO DELAY THE
REQUIREMENT THAT SCHOOL DISTRICTS ADD AN ADDITIONAL FIVE
DAYS TO THE SCHOOL YEAR.

WHEREAS, the standards of the State Board of Education would require school districts to add an additional five (5) days to the school year; and

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives and the Senate have passed a bill to require school districts to proportionately increase teachers' pay for any additional days required; and

WHEREAS, no new revenues are available for the purpose of providing additional compensation for teachers,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That the State Board of Education is hereby requested to delay implementing the standards requiring school districts to add additional days to the school year until sufficient funds are made available by the General Assembly.
