For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARK. CODE. ANN. §17-82-305(a)(3), DEFINING THE TYPE OF EXAMINATION TO BE TAKEN BY DENTISTS WHO APPLY FOR A CERTIFICATE AS A SPECIALIST; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Ark. Code Ann. §17-82-305(a)(3) is amended to read as follows:

"(3) The application must be on file for at least sixty (60) days prior to the regular meeting of the Board. If the application is accepted, the applicant shall be notified to appear for an examination as defined by the rules and regulations of the Board."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that existing laws for the issuance of a certificate to practice a specialty in dentistry need to be defined; that the provisions for an examination to be given to one desiring a certificate from the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners is necessary to insure the proper enforcement of the provisions governing the practice of dentistry in the State of Arkansas; that there is an emergency need for such a provision and that an enactment of the measure will remedy this situation. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation

of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
