For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PERMIT CERTAIN ELECTED COUNTY OFFICIALS WHO MIGHT NOT OTHERWISE QUALIFY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Any person who is eligible for benefits under the Arkansas State Police Retirement System and who on January 1, 1989, will have served as county sheriff for five consecutive terms and who pays, or causes to be paid, all employer contributions that would have been paid had the person been a member of the system during that period of time together with interest of six percent (6%) per annum, compounded annually from the date the service began to the date payment is received by the Public Employees Retirement System on those contributions, shall be included in the term "employees" for purposes of participation in the Public Employees Retirement System as established in Arkansas Code 24-4-101 et seq.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
