SENATE BILL 221

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARK. CODE ANN. §3-9-303(a), TO PROVIDE THE
CRITERIA FOR LICENSES FOR CAFE OR RESTAURANT WINE SALES, AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Ark. Code Ann. §3-9-303(a) is hereby amended to read as
follows:

"(a) It shall be lawful for any cafe or restaurant, as defined in
§3-9-301, in this state, to sell wines, as defined in §3-9-301, for
consumption with food served in such cafe or restaurant upon obtaining a
license and paying the fee therefor, from the director as provided in this
subchapter."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 and the Arkansas Code Revision
Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
