For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR CIVIL LIABILITY FOR KNOWINGLY
ENTERING THE LAND OF ANOTHER FOR TREBLE THE VALUE OF ANY
DAMAGE OR INJURY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. If any person shall knowingly enter upon the land of another and knowingly damage, injure, or destroy the personal or real property of another person located on the land, the person entering shall be liable to the injured person for treble the value of the property damaged, injured or destroyed and for all costs and reasonable attorneys' fees in any civil action brought under this act.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
