For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE
TRANSPORTATION SAFETY AGENCY SHALL HAVE LIMITED ARREST
POWERS: AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Arkansas Code §12-9-108, persons employed by the Transportation Safety Agency as District Investigator Sergeants, District Investigator Corporals and District Investigators may arrest a person for driving while intoxicated or when the investigator observes reckless conduct of such a nature that the person is in danger of harming himself or others.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
