For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND SUBDIVISION (A) OF SUBDIVISION (3) OF
SUBSECTION (a) OF SECTION 27-14-601 OF THE ARKANSAS CODE
[27-14-601 (a) (3) (A)]: TO CHANGE THE DEFINITION OF CLASS ONE
TRUCKS FOR REGISTRATION AND LICENSING; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Subdivision (A) of subdivision (3) of subsection (a) of
Section 27-14-601 of the Arkansas Code [27-14-601 (a) (3) (A)] is hereby amended
to read as follows:

"(A) Class one - All trucks which are rated regularly and commonly as
having a load capacity of one-half (1/2) ton or less and all trucks which
are rated regularly and commonly as having a load capacity of not exceeding
three fourths (3/4) ton, and all trucks commonly referred to as pickup trucks
with an unladen weight of 3,000 pounds or less shall be assessed a license fee
of twenty-one dollars (\$21.00) without regard to gross loaded weight;"

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
Assembly that the present law governing Class One Trucks for registration and
licensing purposes is inadequate; that certain vehicles which should be so
classified are now classified as Class Two Trucks; that this Act is necessary

to correct this flaw. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
