For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 5-73-209 RELATING TO THE
REGISTRATION OF MACHINE GUNS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-73-209 (a) and (b) are hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) Every machine gun now in this state adapted to use pistol cartridges of 30 (.30 in. or 7.63 mm.) or larger caliber shall be registered in the office of the Secretary of State.

(b) (1) Any person possessing a registered machine gun on the effective date of this act shall reregister the same within ninety (90) days after the effective date hereof.

(2) Any person possessing an unregistered machine gun on the effective date of this act shall register the same within twenty-four (24) hours after the effective date of this act and any person acquiring such machine gun after the effective date of this act shall register the same within twenty-four (24) hours after its acquisition.

(3) A person registering a machine gun with the Secretary of State after the effective date of this act shall not thereafter be required to register or reregister such machine gun unless and until there is a change in the name, address or occupation of persons registering the same, in which case the person shall reregister the machine gun within twenty-four hours after such change."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
