For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 14-51-204 (a) TO PROVIDE THAT CITY CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSIONS SHALL ANNUALLY ELECT THEIR CHAIRMEN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 14-51-204 (a) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) The board of civil service commissioners shall on the first Monday of April of 1989 and annually thereafter select one (1) of the commissioners to serve as chairman of the commission."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the chairmanship of many city civil service commissions changes during the first week in April; that this act provides that the chairmen should be selected by the commission; and that this act must go into effect immediately in order to coincide with the change in chairmanships. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
