For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE TRANSIENT BUYERS OF GOODS FOR RESALE TO REGISTER WITH THE COUNTY CLERK OF THE COUNTY WHEREIN THE GOODS WERE PURCHASED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Every person, firm, corporation and other legal entity which purchases, barter or trades items of personal property for resale shall register with the county clerk of each county wherein the transient buyer buys, barter or trades personal property for resale for a period of less than six (6) months in any year. The transient buyer shall provide the county clerk with his name, address, telephone number and driver's license number. When a transient buyer buys, sell, barter or trades any item of personal property to any other person or legal entity, the transient buyer shall furnish the other person his name, address, telephone number, driver's license number and county registration number.

SECTION 2. Transient buyers shall maintain for three years a record indicating the description of the property bought, sold, bartered or traded, and the name, address, telephone number and driver's license number from or to whom the property was bought, sold, bartered or traded.

SECTION 3. All state, county and city law enforcement officers are authorized to inspect the records which are required by this Act.

SECTION 4. Any person who violates this Act shall be deemed guilty of a class C misdemeanor.

SECTION 5. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature

are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
