For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 12, CHAPTER 9, SUBCHAPTER 3 OF THE
ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987 TO CLARIFY THE DEFINITION OF PART-TIME
LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-9-301(5) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(5) 'Part-time law enforcement officer' as applied to employment and training requirements means any officer working less than twenty (20) hours per week who may receive but need not receive a salary from the employing law enforcement agency;"

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
