For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS RETIRED FROM PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT BY ELECTING THOSE RETIREMENT BENEFITS AFFORDED BY ACT 187 OF 1987 MAY BE CANDIDATES FOR AND MAY HOLD PUBLIC ELECTED OFFICE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of Act 187 of 1987 nor any provisions of the Arkansas Code of 1987 to the contrary, any individual who has retired from public employment by electing the retirement benefits afforded by Act 187 of 1987 may be candidates for and may hold public elected office in the state of Arkansas.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
