For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO ENHANCE THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE UNIFORM
CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE ACT BY PUBLIC OFFICIALS; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) Any public official who commits a felony violation of the Uniform Controlled Substances Act 5-64-101 through 5-64-608, shall have any term of imprisonment imposed for the violation enhanced by a term of two years and a fine of not less than \$1,000.

(b) For purposes of this section, "public official" means any person holding or appointed to an elective office of state, county, or city government, and any member of any board or commission of state, county, city or local government including improvement districts and school districts, and any duly certified law enforcement officer of this state.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
