For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH MINIMUM SALARIES FOR TEACHERS; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. In school year 1990-91 and each school year thereafter, no school district shall pay its teachers less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) per school year which shall be the minimum base salary.

SECTION 2. In school year 1991-92 and each school year thereafter, school districts shall pay teachers with a master's degree and no experience at least one hundred and fifteen percent (115%) of the minimum base salary prescribed in Section 1.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 6-17-1001 through 1005 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
