SENATE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT IF ANY SCHOOL DISTRICT IS MERGED INTO
ANOTHER EXISTING SCHOOL DISTRICT, THE TAX MILLAGE SHALL BE AT
THE RATE APPROVED FOR THE EXISTING SCHOOL DISTRICT; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. If any school district is abolished or is merged into another existing school district, the board of directors of the existing school district shall submit a tax millage to the electors of the school district at the next school election after merger. In the event a majority of electors voting in the annual school election following the merger shall disapprove the proposed rate of tax for the school district, then the tax shall be collected at the rate approved for the existing school district.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
