SENATE BILL 461

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ALL PROPERTY WHICH IS USED OR INVOLVED  
IN A CRIMINAL ATTEMPT OR CRIMINAL CONSPIRACY TO UNLAWFULLY OBTAIN  
CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES SHALL BE SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE; AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. All property which is used or involved in a criminal attempt or criminal conspiracy to unlawfully obtain controlled substances as defined in Arkansas Code 5-64-101 shall be subject to forfeiture under the provisions of Arkansas Code 5-64-505.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
