For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-91-108 TO INCREASE THE PENALTY FOR LATE PAYMENT OF RENEWAL FEES FOR LICENSES ISSUED BY THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY; TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-91-203 TO INCREASE THE PER DIEM FOR MEMBERS OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-91-108(16) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(16) The penalty for late payment of renewal of a permit or license issued by the State Board of Pharmacy shall be twenty dollars (\$20.00) per month from February 1, provided that if the renewal is unpaid by April 1 of any year, the license shall be null and void;"

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 17-91-203 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) The Board of Pharmacy is authorized to reimburse the members of the board for necessary travel, meals, and lodging expenses incurred in the performance of their responsibilities as board members.

(b) The members of the board shall each receive one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per diem while in session attending board meetings."

SECTION 3. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. (a) Arkansas Code 17-91-108(17) is hereby repealed.

(b) All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
