For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO CREATE THE SEPARATE OFFICES OF SHERIFF AND TAX  
COLLECTOR IN FAULKNER COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Effective January 1, 1991, the offices of sheriff and tax collector in Faulkner County shall be separate offices. At the 1990 general election, the electors of Faulkner County shall elect a sheriff and a tax collector and each officer so elected shall take office on January 1, 1991. The sheriff and tax collector in Faulkner County shall each give bond for the faithful performance of their duties as is now or hereafter provided by law.

SECTION 2. The sheriff and the collector of Faulkner County shall each receive such compensation as shall be determined by the quorum court of Faulkner County within the minimum and maximum compensation range prescribed by the General Assembly, and such other deputy hire and other allowances as shall be prescribed by the quorum court.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
