SENATE BILL 527

"AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated to Henderson State University, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts for Henderson State University, the following:

- (C) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 635 of 1987 for academic renovation, in a sum not to exceed ......\$122,730.

SECTION 2. SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated to Southern Arkansas University, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts for Southern Arkansas University, the following:

- (B) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 925 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional,

clinical and agricultural research equipment, in a sum not to exceed..\$16,664.

- SECTION 3. SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated to Southern Arkansas University, to be payable from Institutions Cash Funds for Southern Arkansas University, the following:

(B) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in

equipment for the Environmental Control Academy, in a sum not to exceed
\$16,628
(C) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in

(D) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in

SECTION 6. ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - BEEBE - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT.
There is hereby appropriated to Arkansas State University - Beebe, to be
payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
accounts for Arkansas State University - Beebe, the following:
(A) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in
Item (C) of Section 1 of Act 925 of 1987 for major maintenance, in a sum not
to exceed \$3,789
(B) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in
Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 925 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional,
clinical and agricultural research equipment, in a sum not to exceed
\$4,949
(C) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in
Item (A) of Section 10 of Act 925 of 1987 for the purchase of equipment for
the Arkansas State Technical Institute, in a sum not to exceed \$598,747
SECTION 7. ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - JONESBORO - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT.
There is hereby appropriated to Arkansas State University - Jonesboro, to be
payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
accounts for Arkansas State University - Jonesboro, the following:
(A) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in

- SECTION 9. UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT FAYETTEVILLE GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated to the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts for the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville, the following:
- (A) Effective June 30, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (H) of Section 9 of Act 790 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional, clinical and agricultural research equipment, in a sum not to exceed...\$9,833.

- (D) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 9 of Act 790 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional,

- clinical and agricultural research equipment, in a sum not to exceed..\$12,736.
- (E) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 9 of Act 790 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional, clinical and agricultural research equipment, in a sum not to exceed.. \$8,149.
- (G) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) of Section 9 of Act 790 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional, clinical and agricultural research equipment for Agricultural Experiment Stations, in a sum not to exceed......\$27,257.
- (I) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 925 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional, clinical and agricultural research equipment, in a sum not to exceed..\$205,386.

- (N) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 925 of 1987 for the renovation of University Hall

- (O) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 2 of Act 925 of 1987 for constructing and equipping a Poultry Disease Isolation Laboratory, in a sum not to exceed ...... \$410,755.
- (P) Effective June 30, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (K) of Section 9 of Act 790 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional, clinical and agricultural research equipment, in a sum not to exceed ..\$10,670.
- (Q) Effective June 30, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (L) of Section 9 of Act 790 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional, clinical, and agricultural research equipment at Agricultural Experiment Stations, in a sum not to exceed ......\$19,383.
- (R) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (G) of Section 9 of Act 790 of 1987 for the renovation of Old Main as a historic structure and contingent on dollar for dollar matching funds from outside sources, in a sum not to exceed ......\$37,814.
- SECTION 10. UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT FAYETTEVILLE TRUST FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated to the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Grants and Trust Fund for the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville Archeological Survey, the following:
- (A) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Section 1 of Act 818 of 1987 for the purchase of research equipment, in a sum not to exceed ......\$3,416.
- SECTION 11. UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT LITTLE ROCK GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated to the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts for the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, the following:
- (A) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 925 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional, clinical and agricultural research equipment, in a sum not to exceed ....\$27,033.
- (B) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) of Section 10 of Act 790 of 1987 for the renovation of the Science/Law

SECTION 12. UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS FOR MEDICAL SCIENCES - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated to the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts for the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, the following:

- (B) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 11 of Act 790 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional, clinical and agricultural research equipment, in a sum not to exceed ..\$3,331.
- (C) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 925 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional, clinical and agricultural research equipment, in a sum not to exceed ...\$129,619.
- (D) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 925 of 1987 for renovations and improvements to meet Hospital Fire/Life Safety Codes, in a sum not to exceed ......\$250,000.

- (H) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 11 of Act 790 of 1987 for renovations and improvements to meet Hospital Fire/Life Safety Codes, in a sum not to exceed ......\$13,952.

SECTION 13. UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT MONTICELLO - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated to the University of Arkansas at Monticello, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts for the University of Arkansas at Monticello, the following:

- (B) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 925 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional, clinical and agricultural research equipment, in a sum not to exceed ...\$5,758.
- (C) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 11 of Act 925 of 1987 for the renovation of the Central Utilities Distribution System, in a sum not to exceed ......\$400,000.

SECTION 14. UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT MONTICELLO - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated to the University of Arkansas at Monticello, to be payable from Institutions Cash Funds for the University of Arkansas at Monticello, the following:

(A) Effective April 17, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided
in Item (A) of Section 13 of Act 790 of 1987 for renovating and equipping
Jeter Hall for use by the Agricultural Experiment Station of the University of
Arkansas to conduct forestry and agricultural research, in a sum not to exceed
\$1,050,000.

SECTION 15. UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT PINE BLUFF - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated to the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts for the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 14 of Act 790 of 1987 for constructing, site acquisition and preparation and equipping a Men's Dormitory, in a sum not to exceed ......\$3,488,909.

SECTION 16. UNIVERSITY OF CENTRAL ARKANSAS - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated to the University of Central Arkansas, to be payable

from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts for the University of Central Arkansas, the following:

- (A) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 15 of Act 790 of 1987 for constructing and equipping an addition to Torreyson Library, in a sum not to exceed ......\$1,471,997.
- (B) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 5 of Act 925 of 1987 for constructing, equipping and furnishing an addition to Torreyson Library, in a sum not to exceed ..\$3,044,850.

SECTION 17. EAST ARKANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated to East Arkansas Community College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts for East Arkansas Community College, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 925 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional, clinical and agricultural research equipment, in a sum not to exceed ...\$4,170.

SECTION 18. MISSISSIPPI COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated to Mississippi County Community College, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts for Mississippi County Community College, the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 1989, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (B) of Section 1 of Act 925 of 1987 for the purchase of instructional, clinical and agricultural research equipment, in a sum not to exceed ..\$7,729.

SECTION 19. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded or obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that the Institutions and Agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income, and/or funds available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the said State Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of said project or projects. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for maintenance and general operation of the said

Institutions and Agencies shall not be used for any of the purposes set out in this Act.

(B) The General Accounting Procedures Law, the State Purchasing Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, and other applicable fiscal laws of the State, or their successors, shall be strictly complied with, with respect to use of any funds provided by this Act.

SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 21. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Seventh General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that previous General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the projects enumerated in this Act; that certain appropriations will expire before the adjournment of the Regular Session; and that if such appropriations expire, the programs authorized by such appropriations would cease, thereby depriving the citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived from such projects. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
