For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE COMMITTEE ON PLUMBING EXAMINERS; TO GIVE THE COMMITTEE OF PLUMBING EXAMINERS RULEMAKING AUTHORITY SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OR DISAPPROVAL OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH, AND TO GIVE THE COMMITTEE OF PLUMBING EXAMINERS SOLE AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR LICENSES AND EXAMINATIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created the "Committee on Plumbing Examiners". The Committee shall consist of nine (9) voting members and one (1) nonvoting member. The voting members shall be appointed by the Governor.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
