For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE COUNTY CORONERS TO BE EMPLOYED BY CITIES
AND/OR COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. County coroners may be employed by any city emergency medical service, county emergency medical service, or joint city and county emergency medical service.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that county coroners should be allowed to be employed by local emergency medical services; that this act so provides; and that this act should go into effect immediately in order to grant such authorization as soon as possible. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
