SENATE BILL 596

"AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987 ANNOTATED, SECTION 5-71-225, BY DELETING A PART THEREOF TO INSURE THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THE PROHIBITION AGAINST PICKETING OR DEMONSTRATING BEFORE A PRIVATE RESIDENCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated, §5-71-225, subsection (b) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in demonstrations of any type or picketing before or about any residence or dwelling place of any individual."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
