For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE SUSPENSION OF THE DRIVER'S LICENSE  
OF ANY MINOR CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF THE UNIFORM  
CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. When any person under eighteen (18) years of age is found guilty or pleads guilty or pleads nolo contendere to the violation of the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, the court shall immediately notify the Department of Finance and Administration and the Department shall suspend the offender's motor vehicle operator's license until the offender reaches eighteen (18) years of age.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
