For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A PORTION OF U.S. HIGHWAY SEVENTY-ONE
THE JOHN PAUL HAMMERSCHMIDT HIGHWAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) U.S. Highway 71 from the I-40 intersection to the Missouri line shall be designated as the John Paul Hammerschmidt Highway within the State of Arkansas.

(b) It shall be the responsibility of the State Highway and Transportation Department to place appropriate highway identifying signs on the highway.

(c) The department shall erect appropriate signs along the section of the highway designated herein, indicating that the highway has been designated the John Paul Hammerschmidt Highway.

SECTION 2. This act shall apply to the new U.S. Highway 71 under construction during the 77th Session of the Arkansas General Assembly.

SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
