SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO PERMIT THE INTRODUCTION OF A BILL RELATING TO RETIREMENT
BENEFITS OF COUNTY SHERIFFS UNDER THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES
RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, House Rule 37 provides that no bill affecting a public supported retirement system or pension plan shall be introduced after the thirtieth day of a biennial regular session unless its introduction is first approved by a two-thirds vote of the full membership of each house of the General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the Seventy-Seventh General Assembly is now beyond the thirtieth day of the regular session.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Rules of the Senate are hereby suspended to permit the introduction of a bill relating to retirement benefits of county sheriffs under the Public Employees Retirement System.
