SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION  
ESTABLISHING A COMMITTEE TO EXAMINE THE BUDGETARY PROCESS  
FOR THE STATE OF ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, budgets for the State of Arkansas must be prepared covering a two-year period because of the limitation on the frequency of sessions of the General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the budgetary process has become increasingly complicated; and

WHEREAS, methods should be sought to simplify the budgetary process in order to provide more effective state government,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

That the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House are hereby requested to appoint a committee to study the budgetary process for the State of Arkansas and to make recommendations to the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for methods to simplify the budgetary process or to implement a new budgetary system. The committee shall be composed of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House, three members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker, and three members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro Tempore.
