SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING MR. MAHLON MARTIN ON HIS RECENT ACCEPTANCE OF
THE POSITION OF PRESIDENT OF THE WINTHROP ROCKEFELLER
FOUNDATION AND COMMENDING HIM FOR HIS EXCEPTIONALLY FINE
SERVICE AS DIRECTOR OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
ADMINISTRATION.

WHEREAS, Mr. Mahlon Martin has served this State as Director of the
Department of Finance and Administration since February 1983, having
served as Little Rock City Manager for the period from 1980 to 1983; and

WHEREAS, as Director, Mr. Martin has provided this State with
exceptional leadership and has been described by the Governor as "one
of the finest and ablest men to ever serve our State"; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas General Assembly shares the Governor's description
of Mr. Martin, and has always considered Mr. Martin a tremendous asset to
the State; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Martin has been named to be the next President of the
Winthrop Rockefeller Foundation effective April 3, 1989, which will make
him only the second president in the history of the Foundation, which has
resources exceeding \$55 million; and

WHEREAS, although the members of the General Assembly are delighted
with the naming of Mahlon Martin as President of the Rockefeller Foundation,
both houses of the General Assembly will greatly miss his honesty and
leadership as Director of the Department of Finance and Administration,
