SENATE RESOLUTION

COMMENDING THE PETROLEUM STORAGE TANK SUBCOMMITTEE, THE  
SUBCOMMITTEE CHAIRMAN, REPRESENTATIVE JOHN M. LIPTON,  
AND PROFESSOR ROY WHITEHEAD, JR. FOR THEIR TIRELESS EFFORTS  
TO FORGE THE REGULATED SUBSTANCE STORAGE TANK PROGRAM AND THE  
PETROLEUM STORAGE TANK TRUST FUND LAWS.

WHEREAS, the Joint Interim Committee on Public Health, Welfare and Labor created the Petroleum Storage Tank Subcommittee in 1987 to study the underground storage tank issue; and

WHEREAS, Representative John Lipton very aptly and diligently served as the Chairman of this special subcommittee by guiding its members to a resolution of this highly complex issue; and

WHEREAS, the earnest efforts of the Subcommittee produced three significant pieces of legislation, all of which were handily passed by the Seventy-Seventh General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has signed this legislation into law as Act 172 and Act 173; and

WHEREAS, Professor Roy Whitehead, Jr. from the University of Central Arkansas served as a consultant to the Subcommittee; and

WHEREAS, Professor Whitehead willingly devoted his time, energy and assistance to the Subcommittee enabling them to benefit from his vast experience in this area;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
