CONGRATULATING THE SOUTHERN ARKANSAS MULERIDERS BASKETBALL
TEAM FOR WINNING THE DISTRICT 17 NAIA CHAMPIONSHIP AND
WISHING THEM GOOD LUCK IN THE NAIA NATIONAL TOURNAMENT.

WHEREAS, the Southern Arkansas Muleriders basketball team defeated the University of the Ozarks Eagles 77-71 for the District 17 NAIA championship; and

WHEREAS, the Muleriders have had an exceptional season by finishing second in the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference with a 13-5 conference record and a 24-5 record for the season; and
