> For An Act To Be Entitled "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1991; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS - STATE. There is hereby established for the Department of Health for the 1989-91 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act, or its successor.

SECTION 26. EXTRA SALARIES. The Department of Health is hereby authorized to pay from State or Federal funds appropriated herein extra salaries in addition to the maximum annual amount provided in the Regular Salaries Section of this Act for a maximum of fifteen (15) full-time medical doctors who are certified by the American Speciality Boards, but not to exceed \$4,500 per medical doctor for each fiscal year. The Director of the Department of Health shall also be eligible for extra salaries as established herein.

SECTION 27. RESTRICTIONS. Positions authorized in Section 1 of this Act as Sanitarian I, Class Code Q074; Sanitarian II, Class Code Q076; Sanitarian Supervisor, Class Code Q078; and Health Sanitarian Program Specialist, Class Code Q077; may be utilized by the Department of Health only as authorized and may not be crossgraded or downgraded to any other classification or classifications as authorized by the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act.

SECTION 28. The Director of the Department of Health will have full power, after receiving the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, who has sought prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, to utilize personnel in the agency in such a manner as to meet overall public health priorities and to transfer any appropriation or line item amount to any other appropriation or line item amount provided herein.

SECTION 29. Any employee serving in the capacity of Acting County Health Unit Administrator shall be eligible for up to two (2) steps of additional compensation within the grade during the period of time in which said employee occupies the position. Employees on the highest step of their grade shall be eligible for additional compensation in an amount not to exceed five-and-one-half percent (5.5%) of their current salary upon resuming responsibility, and this amount shall not be construed as exceeding the line item maximum for the grade for that position.

SECTION 30. TRANSFER OF FUNDS. Subject to such rules and regulations as may be implemented by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Disbursing Officer for the Department of Health is hereby authorized to transfer all unexpended funds relative to the Home Health Services that pertain to reimbursement, as certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, as provided in this Act on June 30, 1989, to be carried forward and made available for expenditures for the same purpose for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1990, and June 30, 1991.

SECTION 31. HOME HEALTH - REAPPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Health, to be payable from the Public Health Fund, the following:

Further, the unexpended balances of appropriations authorized in Section 4 of this Act which remain on June 30, 1990, shall be carried forward and made available for the same purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1991.

SECTION 32. Employees occupying the Health Physicist I positions, Nuclear Planning and Response Program, shall be considered a part of the overall Arkansas Department of Health Radiation Control Program, but their official duty station shall be at the Nuclear Planning and Response Headquarters at the site of the Nuclear I and Nuclear II generating facilities in Pope County.

SECTION 33. The Department of Health is hereby authorized to make overtime payments to employees engaged in the performance of home health activities. Such payments are to be in addition to compensation otherwise due said employee at the same rate currently paid to such employee for regular time, but on an hourly basis.

SECTION 34. The funds appropriated in Item (04) of Section 13 of this Act shall be disbursed to those counties in this State which are required by state or federal regulation to maintain a Radiological Response Plan because of their close proximity to a nuclear electricity generating facility, and shall be issued solely for the purpose of defraying the cost of preparing for and participating in actual or practice nuclear disaster exercises. Each county shall be eligible for that proportion of these funds as is determined fair and necessary under guidelines to be developed by the Department of Health. However, a minimum of \$25,000 of said funds shall be utilized to support and operate a County Emergency Services Office (ESO). These county offices shall be prepared to respond to any Arkansas nuclear I emergency. These funds shall be equally distributed to each Emergency Services Office in the following counties: Pope County, Johnson County, Yell County, Conway County and Logan County.

SECTION 35. The Director of the Department of Health is authorized to continue the Mississippi County Midwife program utilizing available State and federal funding.

SECTION 36. HOME HEALTH VISIT PAY. The Department of Health is hereby authorized to compensate licensed nursing personnel responsible for providing skilled home health care services as necessary to maintain continuity of care after 6:00 p.m. and prior to 7:00 a.m. on weekdays and on a weekend or holiday. All compensated services shall be provided as directed by the Department of Health. Visit pay shall not exceed a maximum of \$45 per visit. All visit pay shall be paid from funds from Home Health Extra Salaries as appropriated in this Act. Such compensation for visit pay, when added to employee's regular salary and benefits, shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum annual salary as described in the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law.

SECTION 37. HOME HEALTH FUND BALANCE. It is the intent of the General Assembly that the Department of Health shall not have the authority to transfer funds from the Fund Balance of the Home Health appropriation to supplement line item(s) in any other appropriation authorized for this agency.

SECTION 38. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 39. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 40. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. Act 920 of 1989 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 41. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the

Seventy-Seventh General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1989 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1989 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1989.
