For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF "NEW REVENUES" AND ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW FUND FOR THE TRANSFER OF REVENUES TO VARIOUS FUNDS AND FUND ACCOUNTS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. On the last day of each month commencing with the first month following the effective date of this Act, and for the remainder of the biennial period commencing July 1, 1989, and ending June 30, 1991, the State Treasurer, after making the deductions required from the "Net General Revenue", as set out in Arkansas Code 19-5-202, and transfers provided for in Act 1 of the Second Extraordinary Session of 1989, shall also deduct from said "Net General Revenue" such amounts as are determined and certified to by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to be "New Revenue". "New Revenue" shall consist of that amount of General Revenue which was received during the month due solely to enactments of the Seventy-Seventh General Assembly meeting in Third Extraordinary Session. The State Treasurer shall transfer ninety-seven percent (97%) of such "New Revenue" in accordance with the following procedure:

(A) The State Treasurer shall transfer to the funds and fund accounts listed below, until there has been transferred a total of \$ 13,311,754 for fiscal year 1989-90 and \$ 20,570,509 for fiscal year 1990-91 or as much thereof that may become available, provided that the State Treasurer shall make such monthly allocations in accordance with each fund or fund account's proportionate share of the total of all such allocations set forth herein:

(B) After making the maximum annual allocations provided for in Subsection (A) of Section 1 of this Act, the State Treasurer shall transfer any remaining "New Revenues" to the "Educational Enhancement Transfer Fund" created herein, there to be used for the purposes as provided by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby established on the books of the State Treasurer, State Auditor, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a Fund to be known as the "Educational Enhancement Transfer Fund". Such fund shall be used for fund transfers to the Public School Fund, the Vocational Education Schools Fund Account, Dept. of Higher Education Fund Account (Westark Community College University Center) and the various general revenue funds of the institutions of higher education, there to be used for the respective purposes as provided by law.

SECTION 3. In the event that the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall increase the official forecast of general revenues above that which was certified on April 28, 1989 he shall, on the last day of each month, certify to the State Treasurer the amount that was collected during the month which was attributable solely to the conditions which warranted his revenue estimate revision. Upon receiving such certification, the State Treasurer shall, after making the deductions required from the net general revenue, as set out in Arkansas Code 19-5-202, and transfers provided for in Act 1 of the Second Extraordinary Session of 1989, also deduct ninety-seven per cent (97%) of the amounts as are determined and certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, which shall then be transferred to the Educational Enhancement Transfer Fund, herein created. Provided, however, that no more than \$50,000,000 shall be subject to transfer to the Educational Enhancement Transfer Fund during

each year of the biennial period ending June 30, 1991. The monies accruing to the Educational Enhancement Transfer Fund shall be distributed monthly by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and shall then cause the appropriate transfers of such monies to be made, as follows:

(A) Such funds as are available in the "Educational Enhancement Transfer Fund" during the 1989-90 fiscal year, shall be distributed in accordance with each fund or fund account's proportionate share of the total of all such allocations set forth herein:

SECTION 4. There is hereby established on the books of the State Treasurer, the State Auditor, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as the "Drug War Matching Fund" which shall consist of such funds as may be provided by the General Assembly. The Drug War Matching Fund shall be used for the purpose of matching any federal funds provided under drug law enforcement programs that may become available to the State from the United

States Department of Justice.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Seventh General Assembly meeting in Third Extraordinary Session, that the provisions of this Act are of critical importance to the provisions of governmental goods and services to the people of the State of Arkansas, and to provide sufficient funding for various agencies of state government to accomplish the crucial tasks at hand for the citizens of the State of Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
