HOUSE RESOLUTION

HONORING THE ARKANSAS METHODIST HOSPITAL IN PARAGOULD FOR  
ITS FORTY YEARS SERVICE TO NORTHEAST ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, on October 17, 1949 the Community Methodist Hospital (now the Arkansas Methodist Hospital) in Paragould admitted its first patient; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Methodist Hospital is a not-for-profit hospital serving not only Greene County but the surrounding Northeast Arkansas counties as well as the botheel of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Methodist Hospital is a 129 bed, acute care general hospital; and

WHEREAS, since its opening on October 17, 1949 there have been approximately 31,264 births at the hospital; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Methodist Hospital is staffed by 40 physicians, surgeons and dentists, employs 350 persons, and in addition is served by 125 volunteers; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Methodist Hospital has performed its mission well over the past 40 years, and its people have set an example as caring, competent and compassionate health care providers,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, MEETING IN ITS THIRD EXTRAORDINARY SESSION:

That it hereby recognizes the Arkansas Methodist Hospital at Paragould upon its 40th anniversary and commends its staff, volunteers and board of trustees for their dedicated service to their fellowmen.
