## 7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR OF ARKANSAS TO JOIN WITH  
9 THE GOVERNOR OF ANOTHER STATE IN DECLARING AN LP GAS  
10 SHORTAGE AND THEREBY ALLOW AN LP GAS TRUCK PERMITTED IN  
11 THE OTHER STATE TO TEMPORARILY TRANSPORT GAS IN AND  
12 THROUGH ARKANSAS WITH AN ARKANSAS PERMIT; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16

17 SECTION 1. The Governor of the State of Arkansas may join with the  
18 governor of any other state in declaring an LP gas shortage emergency. When  
19 the declaration is issued LP gas trucks and operators meeting all  
20 certification, permit and licensing requirements of the federal government and  
21 their home state shall be permitted to transport LP gas in and through  
22 Arkansas without obtaining any license, permit or certification by an agency  
23 of the State of Arkansas. The waiver of Arkansas licensing, permitting and  
24 certification laws and regulations regarding LP gas trucks and operators  
25 thereof shall be valid only during the time of the emergency.

27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature  
28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30

31 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to  
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
33 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without  
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
35 Act are declared to be severable.

2       SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are  
3 hereby repealed.

5       *SECTION 5. EMERGENCY.* It is hereby found and determined by the  
6 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly that Arkansas is chiefly a rural state and  
7 that we are entering the coldest portion of the winter season; that shortages  
8 of LP gas threaten the health of our citizenry who reside in the rural areas  
9 of this state; and further that LP gas shortages result in major damage and  
10 loss to the poultry industry of this state. Therefore, an emergency is hereby  
11 declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation  
12 of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force from and after  
13 its passage and approval.
