7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 25-19-105(b) TO REMOVE AN
9 EXEMPTION FROM THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT FOR CERTAIN
10 INFORMATION OF THE ARKANSAS INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT
11 COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

14

15 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 25-19-105(b) is amended to read as follows:

16 "(b) It is the specific intent of this section that the following shall
17 not be deemed to be made open to the public under the provisions of this
18 chapter:

19 (1) State income tax records;

20 (2) Medical records, scholastic records, and adoption records;

21 (3) The site files and records maintained by the Arkansas

22 Historic Preservation Program and the Arkansas Archeological Survey;

23 (4) Grand jury minutes;

24 (5) Unpublished drafts of judicial or quasi-judicial opinions and
25 decisions;

26 (6) Undisclosed investigations by law enforcement agencies of
27 suspected criminal activity;

28 (7) Unpublished memoranda, working papers, and correspondence of
29 the Governor, members of the General Assembly, Supreme Court Justices, and the
30 Attorney General;

31 (8) Documents which are protected from disclosure by order or
32 rule of court;

33 (9) Files which, if disclosed, would give advantage to competitors
34 or bidders; and

1 (10) Personnel records to the extent that disclosure would
2 constitute clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy."

3

4 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
5 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
6 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

7

8 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
10 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
12 act are declared to be severable.

13

14 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
15 hereby repealed.
