# A Bill

**HOUSE BILL**

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## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 23-13-255 TO PROVIDE THE  
8 ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT  
9 ACCESS TO ALL LANDS, BUILDINGS, OR EQUIPMENT OF PRIVATE  
10 CARRIERS USED IN CONNECTION WITH THEIR OPERATION AND ALSO  
11 TO ALL PERTINENT ACCOUNTS, RECORDS, DOCUMENTS, AND  
12 MEMORANDA KEPT OR REQUIRED TO BE KEPT BY PRIVATE CARRIERS  
13 SO THAT ARKANSAS LAWS ARE COMPATIBLE WITH FEDERAL MOTOR  
14 CARRIER SAFETY REGULATIONS, THUS INSURING THE CONTINUED  
15 RECEIPT OF FEDERAL FUNDS WHICH ARE ESSENTIAL TO ARKANSAS  
16 HIGHWAY SAFETY PROGRAMS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 23-13-255 is hereby amended to read as  
22 follows:

23 "23-13-255. Access to property, equipment, and records.

24 The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department or its duly  
25 authorized agents shall, at all times, have access to all lands, buildings, or  
26 equipment of motor carriers and private carriers used in connection with their  
27 operation and also to all pertinent accounts, records, documents, and  
28 memoranda kept or required to be kept by motor carriers and private carriers."

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30 SECTION 2. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
34 act are declared to be severable.

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1        SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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5        SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
6 hereby repealed.

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8        SECTION 5. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the  
9 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Arkansas Code  
10 23-13-255 is incompatible with Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations; that  
11 unless Arkansas Code 23-13-255 is amended, the federal funds received by the  
12 State for highway safety programs of this State will be in jeopardy; that such  
13 federal funds are essential to the highway safety programs of this State, in  
14 particular federal funds received by the State under the Motor Carrier Safety  
15 Assistance Program (MCSAP) which funds are utilized in assisting the  
16 monitoring and enforcement of the safety of trucks on this State's highways,  
17 roads, and streets; and that in the event of an extension of the Regular  
18 Session, the delay in the effective date of this act beyond July 1, 1991,  
19 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of  
20 this essential highway safety program. Therefore, an emergency is hereby  
21 declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the  
22 public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect from and  
23 after July 1, 1991.

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
