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7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE GOVERNOR'S COMMISSION ON ADULT
10 LITERACY FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
16 Governor's Commission on Adult Literacy for the 1991-93 biennium, the
17 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed
18 by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
19 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
20 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
21 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
22 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
23 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
24 Restrictions Act, or its successor.

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1 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
2 Governor's Commission on Adult Literacy, to be payable from the *Public School*
3 *Fund from funds made available for Adult Basic & General Adult Education*, for
4 personal services and operating expenses of the Governor's Commission on Adult
5 Literacy for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

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22 SECTION 3. CARRY FORWARD. The unexpended balance of appropriation and
23 funds authorized for Capital Outlay in Section 2 of this Act on June 30, 1992,
24 shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose during the
25 fiscal year ending June 30, 1993.

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27 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
28 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
30 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
33 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
34 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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1 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
2 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
3 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
4 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
5 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
6 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
7 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of The Arkansas Legislative
8 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

10 SECTION 6. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The agency, Governor's Commission on Adult
11 Literacy, shall not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health
12 insurance per employee than the amount being contributed to the State
13 Employees Health Insurance Program.

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15 SECTION 7. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
16 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
17 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

19 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
20 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
21 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
22 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
23 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
24 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in
25 the effective date of this act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
26 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
27 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
28 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
29 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
