# A Bill

**HOUSE BILL 1277**

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## 7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 24, CHAPTER 7, SUBCHAPTER 6 OF THE  
9 ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987, TO PERMIT THE PURCHASE OF CREDIT IN  
10 THE ARKANSAS TEACHERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR SERVICE IN  
11 CERTAIN PRIVATE SCHOOLS OR AGENCIES; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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16 SECTION 1. Title 24, Chapter 7, Subchapter 6 of the Arkansas Code of  
17 1987 is hereby amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

18 "24-7-607. Private school service.

19 (a) As used in this section, 'private school service' means service  
20 rendered in any private school or agency which is recognized by the State  
21 Department of Education for the issuance of teaching certificates.

22 (b) From and after January 1, 1990, an active member may contract with  
23 the board for private school service to be credited as service hereunder in  
24 accordance with the following conditions:

25 (1) The private school service credit to be granted shall be  
26 limited to service for which no benefit could be paid by another system  
27 similar in purpose to this system, except social security, if the member left  
28 on deposit his contributions to the other system and shall be limited to three  
29 (3) years;

30 (2) The member shall pay to the system for each year of service  
31 credit being granted nineteen and one-half percent (19.5%) of the annual  
32 salary received by him for his first full year of state teaching service,  
33 together with regular annual interest from the end of that year of state  
34 teaching service to the date of payment. If the payment is not made in a  
35 single sum at the time the contract is made, regular interest shall be added

1 from the date of the contract to the date of payment. The payment shall be  
2 credited to the member's account in the member's deposit account and shall be  
3 in addition to regular member contributions thereto;

4                   (3) The private school service shall not become credited service  
5 under this system until:

6                   (A) The member payments specified in subdivision (b) (2)  
7 have been paid in full; and

8                   (B) The member has established ten (10) or more years of  
9 credited service exclusive of private school service. Should a member cease  
10 to be an active member before the private school service has been established  
11 as system credited service, the member payments contributed as specified in  
12 subdivision (b) (2) shall be refundable, together with regular interest  
13 thereon;

14                  (4) The benefit program to be applied to each year of service  
15 credit being granted shall be the benefit program in effect at the time of  
16 retirement;

17                  (5) Such other rules and regulations consistent herewith as the  
18 board may from time to time adopt.

19                  (c) An active member who had both public and private school service in  
20 one (1) school year may contract with the board for one (1) year of service to  
21 be credited as service under this subchapter in the same manner as provided  
22 for private school service under subsection (c) of this section, if the  
23 service meets the following additional requirements:

24                  (1) The combination of public and private school service rendered  
25 in the fiscal school year was not fewer than one hundred twenty (120) days;  
26 and

27                  (2) The person had not less than thirty (30) days of private  
28 school teaching service in the school year and not less than thirty (30) days  
29 public teaching service in the fiscal school year."

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31                 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
32 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
33 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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35                 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
4 act are declared to be severable.

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6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
7 hereby repealed.

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9 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General  
10 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that a shortage exists for public school  
11 teachers in this state; that this act is necessary to encourage certified  
12 teachers who may have left the public school system to teach in certain  
13 private schools to return to public school teaching; that it is in the best  
14 interest and welfare of the people of the State of Arkansas that this act  
15 become effective immediately upon passage. Therefore, an emergency is hereby  
16 declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the  
17 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and  
18 after its passage and approval.
