7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 *"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 20-22-712 TO PROHIBIT THE*
9 *SALE OF FIREWORKS TO CHILDREN UNDER SIXTEEN (16) YEARS OF*
10 *AGE OR TO ANY PERSON KNOWN TO BE INTOXICATED OR*
11 *IRRESPONSIBLE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."*

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF
14 ARKANSAS:

16 SECTION 1. *Arkansas Code 20-22-712 is hereby*
17 *amended to read as follows:*

18 *"20-22-712. It shall be unlawful to offer for retail*
19 *sale or to sell any fireworks to children under the age of sixteen (16) years*
20 *or to any person known to be intoxicated or irresponsible. A sign stating 'No*
21 *sales will be made to anyone under sixteen (16) years of age' shall be posted*
22 *in a conspicuous place where fireworks are sold and shall contain lettering no*
23 *smaller than four (4) inches in height."*

25 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
26 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
27 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

28

29 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
30 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
31 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
32 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
33 act are declared to be severable.

35 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

1 hereby repealed.
