HOUSE BILL 1557

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7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARK. CODE ANN. §24-3-102 TO INCLUDE
9 COMPLIANCE OFFICERS OF THE ARKANSAS LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY
10 COMMISSION AS PUBLIC SAFETY MEMBERS FOR RETIREMENT
11 PURPOSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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15 SECTION 1. Ark. Code Ann. §24-3-102(5) is hereby amended to read as
16 follows:

17 "(5) 'Public safety member' means a member whose covered employment is
18 for personal services as a police officer or fire fighter. 'Police officer'
19 means any regular or permanent employee, whose primary duty is law enforcement
20 of a municipal police department, a county sheriff's office, or the Arkansas
21 State Police, including probationary police officers, and shall also include
22 wildlife officers of the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission and
23 compliance officers of the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission. The
24 term 'police officer' shall not include any civilian employee of a police
25 department or any person temporarily employed as a police officer during an
26 emergency. 'Fire fighter' means any regular or permanent employee of a fire
27 department whose primary duty is fire fighting, including probationary fire
28 fighters, but the term 'fire fighter' shall not include any civilian of a
29 fire department or any person temporarily employed as a fire fighter during an
30 emergency;"

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32 SECTION 2. Title 24, Chapter 3, Subchapter 1 of the Arkansas Code of
33 1987 is hereby amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

34 "24-3-107. (a) The additional cost to the system of the inclusion of
35 compliance officers of the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission in public

1 safety member service shall be the responsibility of the Arkansas Livestock
2 and Poultry Commission and the commission shall pay to the system any
3 additional percent of covered payroll, as computed by actuarial determination,
4 at the same time as employer contributions are paid by law for other
5 commission employees.

6 (b) It is the specific intent of this section to provide that the
7 contributions determined by actuarial valuation shall be in addition to those
8 required by Ark. Code Ann. §24-3-103(c)."

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10 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
11 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
12 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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14 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
15 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
16 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
17 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
18 act are declared to be severable.

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20 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
21 hereby repealed.

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23 SECTION 6. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the
24 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that compliance
25 officers of the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission should be included
26 as public safety members for retirement purposes; that this act includes these
27 officers within the definition of "public safety member" as it pertains to the
28 retirement laws of this state; and that this act is necessary in order for
29 compliance officers of the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission to
30 receive the same treatment under the retirement laws of this state as other
31 compliance officers. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and
32 this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
33 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
34 and approval.
