For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY
10 COMMISSION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993;
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - GENERAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby
16 established for the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission for the 1991-93
17 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries
18 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
19 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all
20 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
21 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
22 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All
23 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
24 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
25 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

7 SECTION 18. A Junior Livestock Show is authorized for each of the five
8 (5) Livestock Show Districts of the State. Any organization desiring to
9 establish a District Junior Livestock Show shall make application and submit
10 proposed organizational and operational plans therefor to the Arkansas
11 Livestock and Poultry Commission. The Livestock and Poultry Commission is
12 authorized to approve only one District Junior Livestock Show in each of the
13 five (5) Livestock Show Districts. Only those District Junior Livestock Shows
14 approved by the Livestock and Poultry Commission shall be eligible to
15 participate in the funds appropriated in Item (04) of Section 16 hereof. Each
16 such approved show shall be entitled to receive Four Thousand Dollars
17 (\$4,000), or as much thereof that is available, from the funds appropriated in
18 Item (04) of Section 16 hereof, to be used exclusively for premiums for
19 livestock and poultry entries of Arkansas 4H and FFA members.

20

21 SECTION 19. Funds appropriated in Item (05) of Section 16 of this Act
22 shall be used to reimburse members of high school 4H clubs, high school FFA
23 clubs, the Arkansas Razorback State High School Rodeo Association and Miss
24 Arkansas Rodeo for expenses incurred while representing the State of Arkansas
25 at national conferences and events outside the State. The State 4H
26 Association, the State FFA Association, the Arkansas Razorback State High
27 School Rodeo Association and Miss Arkansas Rodeo shall receive funds
28 appropriated for expense reimbursement of student members but shall be limited
29 to \$1550 each, or so much thereof that is available, for the State 4H
30 Association, the State FFA Association and the Arkansas Razorback State High
31 School Rodeo Association; reimbursement of expenses for Miss Arkansas Rodeo
32 ~~shall be limited to \$350 per year.~~

33 Claims for expense reimbursement shall be made on behalf of student
34 members by the president, secretary, treasurer, or other executive officer of
35 the association in which the student participates. Such claims shall be made

1 on forms to be prescribed and furnished by the Commission. Each of the
2 associations shall annually submit to the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry
3 Commission an itemized listing of all expenditures. The receiving association
4 shall file with the Commission a detailed listing of payees, amounts, canceled
5 checks, receipts and invoices in support thereof. The documentation of
6 expenditures as set forth in this section shall be maintained by the
7 Commission until audited by the Division of Legislative Audit.

8

9 SECTION 20. RESTRICTION. The Appropriation authorized for the Buffalo
10 Gnat Control Program in Item (06) of Section 3 of this Act, shall be expended
11 only for the control of buffalo gnats in the Arkansas counties of Miller,
12 LaFayette, Little River and parts of Hempstead.

13

14 SECTION 21. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of appropriation
15 provided in Section 6 of this Act, which remains at the close of the fiscal
16 year ending June 30, 1992, shall be carried forward and made available for the
17 same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993.

18

19 SECTION 22. Funds appropriated in Item (7) of Section 3 shall be
20 disbursed by the disbursing officer of the commission upon receipt of a
21 properly completed agreement for depopulation of Brucella abortus field strain
22 infected cattle herds and after consignment to an approved slaughter
23 establishment. Such agreement shall contain eligibility requirements,
24 depopulation procedures, restocking requirements, and endorsements by owner
25 and necessary state officials. The per head indemnity allowed for each
26 eligible animal will be set annually or as necessary by the commission to
27 coincide with available funds.

28

29 SECTION 23. Funds appropriated in Item (07) of Section 16 shall be
30 disbursed by the disbursing officer of the Livestock and Poultry Commission
31 upon receipt of a properly executed application and bond. These funds
32 shall be used exclusively for payment of travel expenses incurred by members
33 of the Arkansas Razorback State High School Rodeo Association for representing
34 the state of Arkansas at national conferences and events outside the state.
35 Disbursement of funds shall also be contingent upon the association providing

1 matching funds on a dollar for dollar basis and certifying to such in
2 application. Expenditures must be supported with canceled checks and
3 applicable invoices and receipts. Such records must be made available to the
4 Livestock and Poultry Commission fair administrator for audit each year.

5
6 SECTION 24. In order to fund or partially fund the pseudorabies control
7 and eradication program there is hereby levied a fee of one dollar (\$1.00) per
8 head on all spent sows and boars sold at livestock markets.

9 Each livestock market operator shall collect fees and remit monthly to
10 the director of the Department of Finance and Administration. The director of
11 the Department of Finance and Administration may promulgate such rules and
12 regulations as it deems necessary to implement the collection of the fee.

13 After deducting three percent (3%) for credit to the Constitutional
14 Officers Fund and the State Central Services Fund the remainder of funds so
15 remitted to the director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
16 be deposited in the State Treasury as special revenues and credited to the
17 Livestock and Poultry Commission Swine Testing Fund.

18 Before the close of each fiscal year, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
19 State shall determine the amount of funds which will remain at the end of the
20 fiscal year in the Livestock and Poultry Commission Swine Testing Fund from
21 fees collected under the provisions of this section. The Chief Fiscal Officer
22 shall allow such funds to be carried forward and made available for the same
23 purpose in the next succeeding fiscal year.

24
25 SECTION 25. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
26 by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
28 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
29 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
30 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of
31 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
32 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
33 with in disbursement of said funds.

34
35 SECTION 26. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

1 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
2 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act
3 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
4 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
6 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
7 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

8

9 SECTION 27. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
10 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
11 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

12

13 SECTION 28. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
14 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
15 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
16 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
17 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

18

19 SECTION 29. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
20 with this Act are hereby repealed.

21

22 SECTION 30. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Arkansas Livestock and Poultry
23 Commission shall not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health
24 insurance per employee than the amount being contributed to the State
25 Employees Health Insurance Program.

26

27 SECTION 31. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
28 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
29 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
30 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
31 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
32 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
33 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
34 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
35 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

1 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
2 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
