# A Bill

**HOUSE BILL**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 24, CHAPTER 11, SUBCHAPTER 4 OF THE  
9 ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987 TO PROVIDE A MINIMUM MONTHLY  
10 RETIREMENT BENEFIT FOR RETIRED POLICEMEN; AND FOR OTHER  
11 PURPOSES."

12  
13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

14  
15 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §24-11-424 is hereby amended to read as  
16 follows:

17 "24-11-424. Benefits - Retirant receiving less than one-half salary.  
18 Retired police officers who are eligible to receive benefits from a  
19 policemen's pension and relief fund shall receive from the policemen's pension  
20 and relief fund a minimum monthly benefit of no less than three hundred fifty  
21 dollars (\$350)."

22  
23 SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 1 shall apply to retirants who are  
24 receiving benefits from a policemen's pension and relief fund on the effective  
25 date of this act and those who are eligible to receive benefits in the future.

26  
27 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30  
31 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
34 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
35 act are declared to be severable.
