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7 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR GRANT PAYMENTS BY THE
9 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - DIVISION OF ECONOMIC AND
10 MEDICAL SERVICES WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN
11 ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 44 OF THE
12 FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF 1989, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
13 ENDING JUNE 30, 1991; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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17 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
18 Department of Human Services - Division of Economic and Medical Services, to
19 be payable from the Department of Human Services Paying Account as designated
20 by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for grant payments by the Department
21 of Human Services - Division of Economic and Medical Services which shall be
22 supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 4 of Act
23 44 of the First Extraordinary Session of 1989, for the remainder of the fiscal
24 year ending June 30, 1991, the following:

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33 SECTION 2. FUNDING TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of
34 this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books
35 and those of the State Treasurer the sum of two million eight hundred sixty-

1 one thousand five hundred ninety-one dollars (\$2,861,591) from the Budget
2 Stabilization Trust Fund to the Department of Human Services Paying Account as
3 designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to provide funds for the
4 appropriation provided herein.

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6 SECTION 3. FUNDING TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of
7 this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books
8 and those of the State Treasurer the sum of twelve million ninety-six thousand
9 three hundred thirty-six dollars (\$12,096,336) from the General Revenue
10 Allotment Reserve Fund to the Department of Human Services Paying Account as
11 designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to provide funds for the
12 appropriation provided herein.

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14 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
15 by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
16 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
17 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
18 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
19 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of
20 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
21 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
22 with in disbursement of said funds.

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24 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
25 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
26 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
27 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
28 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
29 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
30 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
31 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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33 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
34 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
35 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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1 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
2 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
3 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
4 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
5 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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7 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
8 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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10 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
11 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that funds provided by the Seventy-Seventh
12 General Assembly for the operations of the Department of Human Services -
13 Division of Economic and Medical Services are, due to unforeseen
14 circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Human Services - Division of
15 Economic and Medical Services to continue to provide essential governmental
16 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies
17 for the Department of Human Services - Division of Economic and Medical
18 Services to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of
19 this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
20 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
21 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
22 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and
23 effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
