## For An Act To Be Entitled

7 "AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 26, CHAPTER 75, SUBCHAPTER 6 OF THE  
8 ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987 TO PERMIT THE LEVY OF A ONE PERCENT  
9 (1%) TAX FOR IMPROVEMENT OF CITY PARKS UNDER THE DOMAIN OF  
10 THE CITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15 SECTION 1. Subsection (b) of Arkansas Code §26-75-602 is hereby amended  
16 to read as follows:

17 "(b) Any city of the first class in which is located a city park of one  
18 thousand (1,000) acres or more or which has domain and control of a city park  
19 of one thousand (1,000) acres or more, may, in a like manner, levy an  
20 additional tax of one percent (1%) upon the gross receipts or gross proceeds  
21 from the renting, leasing, or otherwise furnishing of hotel or motel  
22 accommodations for profit in the city or upon the gross receipts or gross  
23 proceeds of restaurants, cafes, cafeterias, and other establishments engaged  
24 in the business of selling prepared food for consumption on the premises in  
25 the city. Revenues collected from this additional tax shall be used and  
26 controlled by the city parks and recreation department for the promotion and  
27 development of city parks and recreation areas."

28

29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32

33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
2 act are declared to be severable.

4 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
5 hereby repealed.
