HOUSE BILL 1753

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE NOTICE OF INSURANCE

CANCELLATION TO TRUCK BROKERS; AND FOR OTHER

PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Prior to the cancellation of any Commercial Automobile/Truck Liability Policy or Motor Truck Cargo Policy issued to Private, Exempt or ICC Regulated Motor Carriers, notice of the cancellation shall be mailed or delivered by the insurer to any "Truck Broker" who desires to be notified and who has requested notification in writing. Such notice shall be given no less than the number of days prior to cancellation specified in the policy given to the insured. For purposes of this section, "Truck Broker" shall include, but not be limited to, persons or organizations licensed by the Interstate Commerce Commission to act as an agent to obtain freight and negotiate freight contracts for owners or operators of independently owned trucks for a fee or commission.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
