# A Bill

**HOUSE BILL**

## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE THE SALARY AND EXPENSE ALLOWANCES FOR  
9 THE DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY; AND  
10 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

14 SECTION 1. The deputy prosecuting attorney of Lafayette County shall  
15 receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor  
16 more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) as may be prescribed by the quorum  
17 court and to be paid in equal monthly amounts out of the general revenues of  
18 the county. In addition the deputy prosecuting attorney shall be paid an  
19 amount not to exceed thirty-five hundred dollars (\$3,500) per year as an  
20 office expense allowance to be set by the quorum court and to be paid from the  
21 general revenue fund of the county in equal monthly amounts.

23 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature  
24 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
25 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

27 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to  
28 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
29 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without  
30 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
31 Act are declared to be severable.

33 SECTION 4. (a) Act 30 of 1987 is hereby repealed.

34 (b) All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby  
35 repealed.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the salary of the deputy prosecuting attorney of Lafayette County is insufficient to adequately compensate the person filling the position; that the expense allowance is presently insufficient to reimburse the deputy prosecutor for expenses incurred in connection with the office and that the immediate passage of this Act is necessary to provide the quorum court the necessary flexibility to adjust the salary level and expense account of the deputy prosecuting attorney of Lafayette County. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
