HOUSE BILL

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE GOVERNOR'S MANSION COMMISSION
10 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
14

15 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
16 Governor's Mansion Commission for the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum
17 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions
18 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201
19 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,
20 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set
21 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
22 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
23 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
24 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
25 successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Governor's Mansion Commission, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Governor's Mansion Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

SECTION 3. TRANSFER PROVISIONS. Any unexpended balance of any appropriation provided in this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, shall be transferred forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993.

SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

1 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
2 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
3 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
4 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
5 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
6 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

8 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
9 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
10 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

12 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
13 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
14 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
15 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
16 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

18 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
19 with this Act are hereby repealed.

20

21 SECTION 9. HEALTH PREMIUMS. The Governor's Mansion Commission shall
22 not, during the 1992-93 fiscal year, spend more for health insurance per
23 employee than the amount being contributed to the State Employees Health
24 Insurance Program.

26 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
27 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of
28 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year
29 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the
30 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,
31 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
32 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm
33 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
34 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
35 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and

1 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991.
